Dive Deeper With Dr. Beverly McMillan

What is the big deal about the “Morning After” pill and contraceptive pills?

Some products that are considered ‘birth-control’ can cause an early abortion, meaning they are ‘abortifacient.’ Abortifacient means that a device/substance is capable of unnaturally ending the life of a pre-born child. Hormonal contraceptives are a birth control method that use synthetic hormones.

To deeply understand the differences and similarities between the Morning After’ pill and hormonal contraceptives, it is important to review how life begins. Pregnancy is an amazing process.

Human pregnancy requires two basic elements – a human sperm from a man and a human egg or ovum from a woman.

In order to become pregnant, a woman must ovulate, releasing an egg from her ovary into her fallopian tube. This event typically happens in a woman’s body once a month. After the man releases his sperm into the woman’s vagina, the sperm must travel through the vagina, past the cervix and up into the fallopian tubes. This is where the man’s sperm joins with the woman's egg. When the sperm penetrates the egg and fertilizes it, a new human life begins. The fertilized egg (called a zygote) continues traveling down the Fallopian tube into the uterus, a journey of several days. About 7 to 10 days after conception, the baby, now called a blastocyst, attaches itself to the lining of the uterus, where it will continue to live and grow for approximately 9 months.
